- Ordinance No. 714, an ordinance relating to the millage and the amount to be levied on taxable property within the Town of Odessa for year 2021 was read for the first reading and discussed. Ordinance No. 714 was approved and carried upon a motion by Councilmember Hunt, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.
- Community members were interested in knowing if the bathrooms are available to winter walkers who use the Community Center building during the cold months. The bathrooms are currently closed to the general public due to the Coronavirus Pandemic. Council discussed that they are not interested in opening up the bathrooms at this time to the general public. Walkers will also need to sign a waiver with the Town Clerk's office to use the facility to walk in. There are public restrooms across the street that can be utilized and are open to the public.
- Building Permit 2020-29 for re-roof on detached garage at 201 W 4th Ave. was approved with signature from building inspector upon a motion by Councilmember Iverson, seconded by Councilmember Hunt.
