

Odessa Town Council Minutes
February 25, 2019

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Crossley called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Councilmember Iverson, Councilmember Hunt, Councilmember Kramer, Councilmember Lobe, Councilmember Watkins, PWD Webster, Police Chief Dell, Clerk/Treasurer Snead and public citizens. Fire Chief Strebeck was absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The February 11, 2019 Council meeting minutes were discussed, read and approved upon a motion by Councilmember Iverson, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS

- The February 28th Claims checks # 8390-8403 and one wire transfer totaling \$24,596.18 were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

- Building Permit 2019-01 Fence was approved upon a motion by Councilmember Lobe seconded by Councilmember Hunt.

- James Lathrop's request to reduce the sewer charges to debt portion only was approved upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.

FIRE REPORT

Mayor Crossley and Councilmember Lobe commented that the Firemen's Auction had a good turnout.

POLICE REPORT

Police Chief Dell discussed departmental activities. Council approved, by consensus, a request by Chief Dell to apply for a grant for a police vehicle.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

PWD Webster reported on departmental activities.

COUNCIL REPORT

Council discussed the acquisition of the property, owned by the Catholic Diocese, for the cemetery expansion. There is a verbal agreement that the Catholic Diocese will donate the property to Odessa. Council decided that a transfer of title should be drawn up and sent to them for signature.

MAYORS REPORT

The Mayor reported that he met with the FBLA. They have received funding for and will be able to replace more windows than anticipated for OTH.
