

Odessa Town Council Minutes

April 27, 2020

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Crossley called the regular meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. This meeting was held via the ZOOM app due to the Coronavirus Pandemic and the Meeting ID and the Password were made available to the public through Facebook, posted on the office door and posted on the post office community board. Present were Councilmember Hunt, Councilmember Iverson, Councilmember Kramer, Councilmember Lobe, Councilmember Watkins, Clerk/Treasurer Snead and no public citizens chose to participate.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The April 13, 2020 Council minutes were discussed, read and approved upon a motion by Councilmember Hunt, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS

- The April 27, 2020 claim vouchers #9299 to #9317 totaling \$17,033.00 were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Iverson, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.
