REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Crossley called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Due to lack of quorum the meeting was adjourned to Wednesday, 4/10/2019.

MEETING CALL TO ORDER 4/10/19

Mayor Crossley called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Present were Councilmember Hunt, Councilmember Iverson, Councilmember Lobe, Councilmember Watkins, PWD Webster, Police Chief Dell, Clerk/Treasurer Snead and public citizens. Councilmember Kramer was absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The March 25, 2019 Council meeting minutes were discussed, read and approved upon a motion by Councilmember Iverson, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS

- The March Treasurer's report, March Payroll checks 8458-8475 with 7 EFT's totaling \$49,297.47 and April 8<sup>th</sup> Claims checks # 8476-8499 totaling \$38,438.73 were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Hunt, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.

NEW BUSINESS

- Mayor Crossley announced that Odessa may be applying for another CDBG Grant and a motion is needed to set and advertise the required Public Hearing for May 13, 2019 at 7:00p.m. Councilmember Watkins so motioned with Councilmember Lobe seconding. Motion passed.

Police Chief Dell reported on departmental activities.

Discussion of the USDA police vehicle 55%grant/45%match ensued. Council expressed, by consensus, their preference to add "used vehicle" to the USDA application and see how that goes before trying other options.
