

Odessa Town Council Minutes

May 26, 2020

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Crossley called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. This meeting was held via the ZOOM app due to the Coronavirus Pandemic Present were Councilmember Hunt, Councilmember Iverson, Councilmember Kramer, Councilmember Lobe, Councilmember Watkins, Clerk/Treasurer Snead and a public citizen.

ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

Under “ New Business” Item d – Cares and CDBG Programs and Item e – Building Permit 2020-15 Fence were added.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The May 11, 2020 Council minutes were discussed, read and approved upon a motion by Councilmember Kramer seconded by Councilmember Hunt.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS

- The May 26, 2020 claim vouchers #9341 to #9360 plus totaling \$17,043.49 were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Hunt, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Municipal Park District meeting with all concerned parties with Mark DeWulf is scheduled for Wednesday. We expect to be able to open the pool in Phase 3. The DOH has extensive protocols that will be hard to follow. This was tabled until the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

- Council approved the amended Century West Engineering contract upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.

The Interlocal Agreement between Odessa and Lincoln County was tabled by Councilmembers Iverson and Kramer until the next council meeting for further review.

- A letter from the resident at 101 E Marjorie requesting that the overage on her bill be reduced as she has fixed the leak was presented to council. Council approved reducing the water bill upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.

Mayor Crossley discussed the CARES \$27,300.00 COVID19 Relief Program and the CDBG \$6,500.00 COVID19 Relief Program with Council. There is a possibility that these funds can be “passed thru” the Town of Odessa to support our small businesses. There will be an informational phone conference with Margie Hall on Friday. Council approved, by consensus, to have the Mayor move forward with obtaining the funds if possible.

- Building Permit 2020-15 -Fence was approved upon a motion by Councilmember Hunt, seconded by Councilmember Watkins.
