

Odessa Town Council Minutes  
June 25, 2018

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Crossley called the regular meeting to order at 7:03p.m. Present were Councilmember Kramer, Councilmember Hunt, Councilmember Iverson, Councilmember Lobe, Chief Clark, Chief Strebeck, Clerk-Treasurer Snead, and public citizens. Councilmember Watkins was absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The minutes of the June 11, 2018 regular meeting were approved and carried upon a motion by Councilmember Hunt, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS

- The June, 11,2018 claim checks # 7859-7872 in the amount of \$60,455.50 were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Lobe, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Mr. Knorr discussed the need for a speed limit sign on Dobson Rd.
- Mr. Clavel discussed the residency requirement for councilmembers. Research will be conducted.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- Stephen Nelson – CenturyWest Engineering discussed the projects. The CDBG Water Project is finished and final paperwork completed the New CDBG Emergency Water Grant Project for \$750,000.00 will begin in September, supplemented by the USDA Loan and the EDA Grant.

The FEMA CC Ceiling Grant Project is almost complete. The FEMA Grinder Pumps grant and Cemetery grant have been received and the work completed. Funding from CDBG for the Sewer Project and DOE for the Sewer Project may help solve some problems and eliminate some grinder pumps.

- Building Permit #s 2018-13- fence, and 2018-14 - reroof, and 2018-15 – fence, were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Iverson with Councilmember Lobe seconding.
- Council discussed the Revised Nuisance Ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS

- Yard Clean-up Resolution 2018-07 was approved upon a motion by Councilmember Iverson seconded by Councilmember Hunt.

FIRE REPORT

Chief Strebeck reported that the Fourth of July BBQ is coming up and discussed departmental activities.

POLICE REPORT

Chief Clark reported on departmental activities.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

In his absence, PWD Webster's report on departmental activities and projects was read aloud.

COUNCIL REPORT

Councilmember Kramer discussed the need for some trees in the creek bed to be removed.

MAYORS REPORT

Mayor Crossley reported that he has had complaints of children riding their bikes on the sidewalks and wanted to remind all to walk bicycles on the sidewalk. Mayor Crossley also asked The Odessa-Record-Editor Schmidt-Crosby to note in the paper that construction/improvement projects are inconvenient for everyone and asked that residents have patience.
