

Odessa Town Council Minutes
June 8, 2020

REGULAR ZOOM MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Mayor Crossley called the regular meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Present were Councilmember Iverson, Councilmember Kramer, Councilmember Lobe, Councilmember Watkins, PWD Webster, Clerk/Treasurer Snead and public citizen. Councilmember Hunt was absent.

ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The May 26th 2020 Minutes were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Lobe, seconded by Councilmember Iverson.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS

- The May Treasurer's Report, May Payroll checks #9361-9080 plus 6 EFT's totaling \$39,523.47 and the June 8,2020 claim checks #9381-9397 plus 1 EFT totaling \$37,273.24 were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Mayor Crossley reported for Councilmember Hunt that the petitions to create a Municipal Pool District are available at several places around town.

- The interlocal Government Contract between the Town of Odessa and Lincoln County was approved upon a motion by Councilmember Lobe, seconded by Councilmember Kramer with Councilmember Watkins abstaining due to conflict of interest.

NEW BUSINESS

- Mayor Crossley discussed the \$27,300.00 CARES AND \$6,500.00 CDBG COVID-19 relief programs with Council. Council agreed, by consensus, to share the funds with our local businesses that have been adversely affected by the pandemic.
- Building Permits 2020-16, 17, 18 – all fences- were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Lobe, seconded by Councilmember Kramer.
- A Public Hearing for the CDBG COVID-19 grant and a Public Hearing regarding the undeveloped portion of Seventh Avenue, both scheduled for June 22, were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins, seconded by Councilmember Lobe.
