August 27, 2018

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Crossley called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Councilmember Hunt, Councilmember Iverson, Councilmember Watkins, PWD Webster, Fire Chief Strebeck, Chief Clark, Clerk-Treasurer Snead, and public citizens. Councilmembers Kramer and Lobe were absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The minutes of the August 13, 2018 regular meeting were approved and carried upon a motion by Councilmember Iverson, seconded by Councilmember Watkins.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS

- The August 27, 2018 claims of one EFT and checks #8001, 8032-8044 in the amount of \$69,007.20 were approved upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins, seconded by Councilmember Hunt.

- Council approved closing the Sewer Postage Cash Drawer upon a motion by Councilmember Watkins and seconded by Councilmember Iverson. Credit Cards will be used for postage.
