

ORDINANCE NO. 707

An Ordinance to allow minor improvements on the heretofore unimproved and inaccessible Seventh Avenue, Libsack Addition

WHEREAS, the Town of Odessa Town Council recognizes the need to improve and develop Seventh Avenue for access and due to current construction at this site the cost stands to be affordable and minimal to gravel Seventh Avenue at this time;

WHEREAS, the Town of Odessa Town Council deems it is in the best interest of the Town to have Seventh Avenue used as alley access to the residents along Seventh and Eighth Avenues;

WHEREAS, the Town of Odessa Town Council foresees at a later date, there may be a need for further improvements for which residents may follow OMC 3.28; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ODESSA, LINCOLN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

Section 1.

Seventh Avenue, Libsack Addition , previously platted but inaccessible, will be graded and graveled, thereby making Seventh Avenue accessible.

Section 2. Severability

If any provision of the ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance, or the application of the provisions to other person or circumstances, shall not be affected.

Section 3.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
