

ORDINANCE NO. 710

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ODESSA AMENDING OMC 06.20.070 MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CATS TO COINCIDE WITH OMC 17.08.110 DEFINITION OF A KENNEL

WHEREAS the Town Council deems it necessary to amend Odessa Municipal Code Section 06.20.070 and Ordinance 682/Sept 7 regarding the maximum number of cats in a Household that now reads “No person, persons, or household shall keep more than four (4) cats that are over six months of age on any premises in the Town”; and

WHEREAS the Town Council deems it necessary to reword the code to be consistent with the OMC 17.08.110. that reads “Kennel” means a lot or building in which four or more dogs or cats at least four months of age are kept.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ODESSA, LINCOLN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

SECTION 1. Amend section 06.20.070 to now read:

No person, persons, or household shall keep more than three (3) cats that are over four months of age on any premises in the Town.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any provision of the ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance, or the application of the provisions to other person or circumstances, shall not be affected.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
