

RESOLUTION 2020-11

A RESOLUTION FIXING MONTHLY SUPPLEMENTAL SEWER SURCHARGES FOR LIMITED BID PACKING, LLC AND ALL FUTURE CATEGORICAL INDUSTRIES

WHEREAS, the Odessa Town Council approved and adopted Resolution 2016-9, fixing monthly supplemental sewer surcharges for CPOW, livestock processors cooperative association (LPCA); and

WHEREAS, the LPCA has closed its doors for business and the Limited Bid Packing, LLC has acquired ownership; and

WHEREAS, The Odessa Town Council has requested a copy of Limited Bid Packing, LLC’s Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) be delivered to the Town by the fifteenth (15th) of each and every month, to monitor Limited Bid Packing, LLC’s BOD and all future categorical industries discharge; and

WHEREAS, THE Odessa Town Council, with assistance from the Town’s engineer, have reviewed and determined the monthly supplemental surcharges shall be set for Limited Bid Packing, LLC’s and all future categorical industries, effective beginning July 13, 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Odessa Town Council of the Town of Odessa, the following monthly supplemental surcharges for Limited Bid Packing, LLC and all future categorical industries be approved:

- DMR not delivered by 15th each month.....\$20.00
- The Town will calculate the number of equivalent residential units (ERUs) for each loading parameter (average daily flow, BOD, and TSS) based upon the following criteria to determine the actual number of ERUs to charge the LPCA each month for sewer service. (each ERU rate is 1 ERU plus 25% surcharge-outside town limits)
 - Flow Rate1 ERU is 120 gallons per day
 - BOD.....1 ERU is 0.3 pounds per day
 - TSS.....1 ERU is 0.1 pounds per day

The highest calculated equivalent residential units for these parameters will be used in determining the monthly sewage charge to the Limited Bid Packing, LLC, rounded up to the next highest whole number with a minimum charge of 4 ERUs per month.
